Subject: SSN 702 CWMF Project Groundbreaking Ceremony

The ceremony is scheduled to begin at 0800 on Saturday, August 1st at Steele Indian School Park. A reserved spot for the submarine float has been approved. The expectation is that the float will be positioned as a static display. The 702 CWMF plans on bringing a table to display selected 702 artifacts next to the float. Our submarine float will be positioned by 0700. The event is being sponsored by the PHX Parks department and will provide chairs, tables, podium, and a continental breakfast. About 50 chairs to be set up. The formal event should last approximately 30 minutes to an hour. After the formal event, the expectation is that the Media (CH3, Ch5, AZ republic, and a couple of local neighborhood newspapers) will be covering the event and interviewing the participants. Parking will be a challenge; therefore, arriving early is recommended. Enter the park from Indian School Road.

If you attend, wear your vest and submarine cap. We had a great turnout at the project reveal event in April 2024. Let's repeat it again.
