Webmaster – Dan Marks

Facebook includes an EVENTS feature similar to the HOT ITEMS page on the website. I have a dilemma that the earlier I post an event, the less we know about it. One of the most common member posts in our Facebook group is a request for event times, locations and directions. Sometimes we just don't get those details from the event organizers until the "last minute," but sometimes the Board just isn't sharing what we know in a timely manner.

During June, there were approximately 3,412 page views on the Perch Base website during 2,507 sessions by 2,212 users based on Google Analytics. Approximately 42% of the visits originate in the US, 27% from Russia, 2% from the United Kingdom and the remaining 29% are not specified or widely scattered around the world. Approximately 11% of the visits are from locations within Arizona. The Homepage accounted for the largest (63%) percentage of the visits, exceeding the Glossary (32%.) There were 30 (1%) visits to the Eternal Patrol page.
