Chris reported the deadline for input to the next MidWatch Newsletter is Friday, March 17, 2023. Chris emphasized that input to the MidWatch is welcome from ALL members, including articles, jokes, etc.

Webmaster - Dan Marks

Major activity with the website since the last BOD meeting included posting the Laveen Parade photos, Annual Awards Banquet photos, the Dave Wickline presentation during the January monthly base meeting and the Perch Base Scholarship Application has been updated, as discussed at the last BOD meeting. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics, base correspondence and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted and links updated. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Page.

During January, there were 1,020 page views on the Perch Base website during 492 sessions by 354 users based on Google Analytics. These numbers are slightly lower than typical. During the month, approximately 81% of the sessions originated in the US,5% from China, 2% from the United Kingdom, and the remainder were widely scattered around the world. Approximately 27% of the U.S. based sessions were from locations in Arizona, which is assumed to come from our membership. Most of the traffic was to the home page (38%), followed by the Sailing Orders (14%), Glossary (10%) and the Minutes Selection page (5%).

During January, the Facebook Post Reach (The number of people who saw any of our posts at least once. Reach is different from impressions, which may include multiple views of your posts by the same people.) was 367. The Post Engagements (The number of reactions, comments, shares and clicks on our posts.) was 155. Our Facebook page had 0 new Page Likes for a total of 154 and 170 followers. These numbers are slightly lower than typical. The top post was the ASSM cleanup page.

Chief Of the Boat – Don Robertson

Don reported on the planning for the Annual Picnic at the Paloma Community Park in Peoria. We will be serving sirloin burgers, beef franks and Italian sausages, as well as dishes that may be brought by members. He discussed that he is completing the Maricopa County Food Safety qualification to ensure we meet requirements for serving food.

Don is now keeping the "People Trailer" on his Dewey property due to Chuck Emmett being on the Binnacle List.

Don informed us that he will be issuing a questionnaire in the near future to survey the membership how the Board can serve you better.
