Activity with the website since the last BOD meeting included posting photos Memorial Day and Tolling of the Boats ceremony at the National Cemetery of Arizona, the Ray Marshall Tribute Banner in Gilbert, an invitation to the NOUS History Society presentation on "The Battle of Midway, June 1942 - from the Japanese Perspective," and photos from the Melinda Piña presentation for Honor Flight Arizona at the May 11, 2024, Perch Base General Meeting. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics, base correspondence and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted, and links updated. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Page.

During May, there were 5728 page views on the Perch Base website during 3,491 visits by 2,464 users based on Awstats. This is a continuation of the increased traffic over the past 3 months increase. Most of the traffic was to the home page, followed by the Glossary, and then the Sailing Orders page. The majority of the page views were from the U.S., followed by China, then the Russian Federation.

During May, the Facebook Post Reach (The number of people who saw any of our posts at least once. Reach is different from impressions, which may include multiple views of your posts by the same people.) was 767. The Facebook Post Engagement (The number of reactions, comments, shares and clicks on your posts) was 126. Our Facebook page had 3 new Page Likes for a total of 195 and 3 new followers for a total of 231. The top post was the "WWII ARIZONANS ON ETERNAL PATROL: The first line of the USSVI CREED is "To perpetuate the memory of our. ." post with 332 Post Impressions, a Post Reach of 327, and a Post Engagement of 23
