## **Webmaster – Dan Marks**

Dan requested photos from those attending the upcoming base activities at next week's Spring Training Game and the USS ARIZONA (SSN 803) Crewmember functions.

Activity with the website since the last BOD meeting included posting an article about the submarine dolphin anniversary, the new 2026 Arizona property tax exemption for VA 100% Disabled Veterans, posting the presentation of the "Sailor of the Year" award to our Chief of the Boat (COB) Kirby Anderson. the presentation by Vice Commander Don Robertson titled "Initial Response Phase 1941 - 1942 (S-Boats & Fleet Boats)" given at the February monthly meeting, the presentation by Artist Steve Voita of his USS Phoenix (SSN-702) artwork and posting the obituary notices for the wives of two of our members, Colleen Williams and Mary Denzien. The website was also updated to reflect the appointment of CC Clarke as Base Storekeeper and Jim Denzien as Base Historian. Additionally, a PowerPoint presentation prepared by Jim Denzien of more photos was added to the Float Construction page. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics, base correspondence and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted and links updated. Similar updates have `been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Page.

During February, there were 11,472 page views on the Perch Base website during 8,482 visits by 6,436 users based on Awstats. The most page views were from the United States, followed by Japan, Vietnam, then China. Most of the traffic was to the home page, followed by the Glossary, Sailing Orders, then the Links page. The most downloads were the usual pages: the Historic List of Submarine Classes, followed by the Hurt Feelings Chit, VA burial benefits, then the Mabus letter.

During February, Facebook Views (The number of times your content was played or displayed. Content includes videos, posts, stories and ads.) was 2,914 (decreased slightly) and the Content Interactions (The number of likes or reactions, saves, comments, shares and replies on your content, including ads. Content can include formats such as posts, stories, reels, videos and more.) was 97 (also decreased slightly). Our Facebook page has a total of 254 Followers, +2 from last month. The top post was the "BRAVO ZULU KIRBY..." receiving the "Sailor of the Year" award.
